COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 730, L.D. 1059, Bill, "An
Act Relating to Certificate of Registration to Practice
Barbering."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'Any registered barber who fails in any year to renew
certificate to practice barbering shall successfully pass a
regular examination conducted by the Board of Barbers before a
new certificate may be issued.' "
