STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT to Determine Liability and Responsibility of Drivers of Fire Apparatus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 92-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 92-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 92-A. Liability of drivers of fire apparatus. In the event a fire department vehicle going to or from a call, or going to or from any call or duty assigned to it, is involved in a collision with any other vehicle, object or person, and there is any liability on the part of the operator of the said fire department vehicle, responsibility of payment for any damage or loss occasioned by such liability shall be on the municipality owning or using the fire department vehicle and it shall not be the responsibility of the driver, unless he was operating the fire department vehicle in a grossly negligent manner.'
