AN ACT Relating to Posting Rates for Lodging Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 166-A, additional. Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 166-A, to read as follows:

'Rates for Lodging Places.

Sec. 166-A. Posted rates for lodging places. No person, corporation, firm or copartnership conducting, controlling, managing or operating, directly or indirectly, any lodging place, licensed under sections 160 to 166, shall post or display the rates for rooms thereof on any sign or billboard unless the minimum and maximum rates for such rooms are conspicuously posted or displayed in letters and numbers of equal size. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$200, for each offense.'
