STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Time of Racing at Scarborough Downs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 87, § 9, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 9 of chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Racing shall be permitted at Scarborough Downs until the hour of midnight each day from May 15th to November 30th July 1st through Labor Day each year except that no racing shall be permitted each year for a period of 4 weeks, beginning in June on the Monday of the last full week therein which has 7 ealendar days; provided, however, that if Gorham Raceways does not hold harness races or meets during said 4 week period, racing under the provisions of this chapter may be permitted at Scarborough Downs until the hour of midnight of each day during said 4 week period.'
