AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor in Clubs to Members of Fraternal
Organizations and Auxiliaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 48, amended. The last sentence of section 48 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 151 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

'Licensed clubs shall not sell liquor except to members and their guests accompanying them, except that veterans' and fraternal organizations duly licensed may sell liquor to members of the same national organization and to members of auxiliaries of the same national organization.'
