## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Solicitation to Purchase Liquor in Hotels and Restaurants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 96-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 96-A, to read as follows:

'Solicitation to Purchase.

Sec. 96-A. Solicitation to purchase. No person shall solicit the purchase of liquor in any hotel or restaurant dining room.'
