IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Travel Allowance for Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 116, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1955 and by chapter 232 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 8. Fees. Grand and traverse jurors attending the Superior Court and jurors attending on any other occasion prescribed by law shall be allowed \$12 for each day's actual attendance per day and 10c a mile for their travel out and home once each week for each day's actual attendance, to be paid out of the county treasury.'
