HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 395, L.D. 1098, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Right of Electric Power Companies to
Take Lands for Lines by Right of Eminent Domain."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 17th, 18th, 19th,
20th and 21st lines the underlined words "except that the Public
Utilities Commission may authorize a location less than 100 feet
from an inhabited dwelling when it shall find upon evidence
submitted by the utility that such location is required by
public convenience and necessity'
