STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Term of Office of Department Heads Appointed by Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 11, § 6-A, additional. Chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 6-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 6-A. Department heads; term of office. All department heads, now appointed by either the Governor or by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council, shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor during his term of office and until their successors are appointed and qualified.'
