STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officials of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and amended by section 1 of chapter 390 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin County: County commissioners, \$1,800 \$2,300; chairman, \$2,400 \$2,900; clerk of courts, \$4,700 \$5,200; county attorney, \$4,000; assistant county attorney, \$3,200; county treasurer, \$4,000 \$4,500; sheriff, \$5,250 \$5,750; register of deeds, \$5,500 \$6,000; judge of probate, \$4,500 \$5,000; register of probate, \$4,500 \$5,000; Auburn municipal court judge, \$3,300 \$3,600; associate judge, \$3,000; Lewiston municipal court judge, \$3,700 \$4,000; recorder, \$3,500 \$3,800; Lisbon municipal court judge, \$1,800; Livermore Falls municipal court judge, \$2,000.
