IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Stipend for Agricultural Societies Conducting Non Pari Mutuel Racing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 17, amended. The 2nd and 3rd sentences of section 17 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 391 of the public laws of 1957, are amended to read as follows:

'One-half of the amounts contributed under ~~the provisions of section 17~~ of chapter 86, **section 14**, and ~~section 13~~ of chapter 87, **section 13**, shall be divided for reimbursements ~~or disbursements~~ in equal amounts to each recipient of the Stipend Fund which conducts pari mutuel racing, **or which conducts and has conducted non pari mutuel racing for the past 5 successive years**, in conjunction with its annual fair if said recipient has improved its racing facilities and has met the standards for facility improvements set by the commissioner ~~of Agriculture~~ for said recipients. If a recipient has not complied with the individual standards set by the commissioner said yearly reimbursements ~~or disbursements~~ shall be paid in equal amounts to those recipients which have met such standards.'
