## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Legal Size of Salmon Taken from Chain of Ponds, Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37, § 45, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 45 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:
  - 'I. A salmon or togue less than 14 inches in length, except in Chain of Ponds and its tributaries, Franklin County, where the legal length of salmon shall be 12 inches:'
