# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT to Facilitate Proof of No Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 65, sub-§ I, additional.** Section 65 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 181 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding a new subsection I, to read as follows:

'I. Failure to show license prima facie evidence of no license. If the operator of any motor vehicle fails or refuses to produce a current valid automobile operator's license on demand of a police officer in uniform, his failure or refusal to produce such a license is prima facie evidence that he has none.'
