STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Release of Spouse's Right by Descent.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 170, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 170 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 9. Husband or wife may bar right by deed, etc. A husband or wife of any age may bar his or her right and interest by descent in an estate conveyed by the other by joining in the same, or in a subsequent deed, or in a deed with the guardian or conservator of the other;, or by giving a sole deed with or without covenants or warranty; but he or she shall not be deprived of such right and interest by levy or sale of the real estate on execution;, but may, after the right of redemption has expired, release such right and interest by sole deed giving or joining in a deed, with or without warranty covenants, as aforesaid.'
