## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Public Hearing for Validity of Act of Town Meeting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 37, sub-§ IV, amended. The 4th sentence of subsection IV of section 37 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 309 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'The requirement for public hearing shall not be a prerequisite to the valid issuance of any bond, note or other obligation of a municipality authorized to borrow money by vote under any such particular article, nor to the validity of any act of the town meeting.'
