**AN ACT Relating to Definition of Public Places under Law Relating to Drinking
in Public Places.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 96, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 96 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'II. Public place defined. "Public place" as used in this section shall mean any common carrier, dance, entertainment, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith or any highway, street or lane, to which the public is invited or has access, or recreation areas, camp grounds, state parks and picnic areas operated by state agencies.'
