COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 790, L.D. 1143, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Underwater Swimming and Diving."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated
subsection "II." of section 10-A and inserting in place thereof
the following:

"II. Operation near marker regulated. Any person operating
a vessel within 100 feet of a device marking the location
of an underwater swimmer or diver shall proceed with
extreme caution. No person shall cause any person on
water skis to pass within 100 feet of any such marking
device."
