SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Materials Used in Certain Buildings Operated by Nonprofit Corporations from Sales and Use Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ XXIV, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection XXIV, to read as follows:

‘XXIV. Materials in certain buildings. Materials used in the construction and equipping of buildings owned and operated by a nonprofit corporation for the purpose of providing housing for the elderly.’
