STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Certain Housing for the Elderly from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ II, ¶ J, additional. Subsection II of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph J, to read as follows:
 - 'J. The real estate and personal property located in a municipality owned and occupied and utilized primarily for the purposes of a nonprofit corporation providing housing for persons 62 years of age and over. Each such corporation shall pay annually to the municipality in which such property is located 10% of the annual gross shelter rent received by such corporation during the preceding 12 months.'
