# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Schools During Teachers County Conventions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 156, amended. Section 156 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 156. Teachers may suspend schools during conventions.** Teachers of public schools may suspend their schools for not more than 2 days in any year during the sessions of such conventions within their counties and also for not more than 2 days in any year during the sessions of any state teachers' convention approved by the commissioner, unless otherwise directed in writing by the school officers, and attend said conventions without forfeiture of pay for the time of such attendance, provided they shall present to the officers employing them certificates signed by the secretaries of such conventions and countersigned by the commissioner, showing such attendance.'
