SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 420, L. D. 1163, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Fixing the Boundaries of Highways and Town
Ways."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd underlined
paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 45." and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'The county commissioners shall bill the municipality for
the cost of procuring and setting monuments. The cost of engineering
shall be borne by the county. Said municipal officers shall maintain
all highway or town way monuments and replace them forthwith when
destroyed.'
