IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Default Under Trustee Process.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 114, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 114 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 392 of chapter 317 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 28. Trustee not appearing defaulted. When a person summoned as trustee neglects to appear and answer to the action, he shall be defaulted and adjudged trustee as alleged but not in excess of the amount of the goods, effects or credits in his hands or possession as trustee of the prinicpal defendant.'
