AN ACT Relating to Dogs Brought to Veterinarian.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 18, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 18 of chapter 140 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Any licensed veterinarian, humane society or shelter accepting such a sick, stray, injured or abandoned dog shall keep the same for a period of 2 weeks and shall be entitled to receive from the State the sum of \$1 per day for such period or part thereof as they shall provide food and shelter, provided ~~that~~ such licensed veterinarian, humane society or shelter shall notify the clerk of their respective ~~town or city~~ **municipality** within 24 hours after accepting such a dog, such notice to include a detailed description of the dog and the circumstances of its finding.'
