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**AN ACT Relating to Prohibition Against Loitering on Private Proper or  
Peeking Therein.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 137, § 41-A, additional.** Chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 41-A, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 41-A. Entering on private property and peeking in nighttime. Who-**  
**ever enters upon the private property of another in the nighttime without lawful**  
**business with the owner or occupant thereof and peeks in the window or door**  
**of any inhabited building or structure located thereon shall be punished by im-**  
**prisonment for not more than 6 months, or by a fine of not more than \$500, or**  
**by both.'**
