AN ACT Relating to Nomination of Primary Candidates at State Conventions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 3-A, § 35, sub-§ II, ¶ H, additional. Subsection II of section 35 of chapter 3-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1961, is amended by adding a new paragraph H, as follows:

‘H. Nominate primary candidates. Nominate candidates for the offices of United States Senate and Representatives to Congress, and state and county offices to be filled by the voters at the ensuing primary election. Candidates so nominated shall not be required to file a primary petition as provided in section 40.’
