AN ACT Relating to Improvement of Town Ways to Ski Areas.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 57-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 57-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 57-A. Improvement of town ways to ski areas. Whenever a substantial investment has been made in the development of skiing recreational areas and facilities in any town, access to which is by town ways, the State shall expend a sum not to exceed \$2,500 per mile to a maximum of 5 miles for the improvement of such ways under the direction of the State Highway Commission. Such sums shall be paid from the General Highway Fund.'
