AN ACT Relating to Area Directional Signs for Belgrade Lakes Region.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 149-A, sub-§ IV, repealed and replaced. Subsection IV of section 149-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

IV. Belgrade Lakes Region: Such signs shall be constructed and maintained on:

A. The Maine Turnpike no more than 2 miles southerly from the Augusta interchange and worded as follows:

Belgrade Lakes Region
Recreational Area
Exit 15

B. Interstate Route 95 southerly of exit 15, and worded as follows:

Belgrade Lakes Region
Recreational Area
Exit 15

C. Interstate Route 95 southerly of the exit to Routes 8, 11 and 27, known as the Belgrade Road and worded as follows:

Belgrade Lakes Region
Recreational Area
Routes 8, 11 and 27;
