### AN ACT Relating to Night Hunting of Skunks and Raccoons.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ IV, amended.** Subsection IV of section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

**IV. Skunk and raccoon.** It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt skunks and raccoons ~~at night~~, except that skunks may be hunted ~~at night~~ from September 1st to December 15th of each year and raccoons may be hunted ~~at night~~ from August 15th to December 15th of each year ~~under the following provisions:~~ when accompanied by a dog; ~~provided that an.~~ An electric flashlight of not more than 3 cells may be used while locating in and taking from a tree any raccoon treed by a dog. It shall be unlawful to use or have in possession any firearm except a .22 caliber pistol while hunting as ~~hereby~~ provided.
