STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting and Trapping of Fisher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ I, amended. The 6th paragraph of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an open season on fisher from November 1st to November 30th of each calendar year for the hunting and trapping of fisher during the months of November, December and January. During such open season any steel traps set for the taking of fisher shall not be less than 6 feet from the ground.'
