STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Any Electronic Devise While Hunting Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 92-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 92-A, to read as follows:

'Use of electronic devices.

Sec. 92-A. Use of electronic devices. It shall be unlawful for any person while hunting deer to use any electronic device for the transmission of communications, such as walkie-talkie.'
