COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 816, L.D. 1203, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Appointment of Clerks of Courts and Clerks
Pro Tempore."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the
following:

"Sec. 1. R.S., c. 89, §3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 89
of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Vacancies happening otherwise. When no choice is
effected or a vacancy happens in the office of county commissioner
by death, resignation ~~or~~, removal from the county or for any other
reason, the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council
shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy, who shall hold office
until the first day of January after another has been chosen to
fill the place. ' "

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
