AN ACT Increasing Pensions of State Employees Retired on Council Orders.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 63-A, § 6, sub-§ VIII, additional. Section 6 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection VIII, to read as follows:

‘VIII. Those retired on council orders. Those state employees who retired on council orders shall have their pension increased by $\frac{1}{2}$ of the present amount they are now receiving, except those cases which have been increased by special resolve.’

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$10,400 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$10,400 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.
