STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Erection of Fish Weirs in Waters Lying Between Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 98, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 98 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 9. Waters lying between 2 towns. In any river or tidewater lying between 2 towns or cities, no such wharf or fish weir described in sections 7 and 8 shall be erected without the consent of the municipal officers of both; and in. In no case shall any wharf be extended beyond any wharf lines heretofore legally established.'
