STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Duty of State Historian in Submitting Names for Designating Memorial Bridges or Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 43, § 5-A, additional. Chapter 43 of the Revised Statutes, as amended is further amended by adding a new section 5-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Names for memorial bridges and highways. The State Historian shall submit to the Legislature the names of persons or subjects whenever any legislation is pending to designate any highway or bridge as a memorial.'
