IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Director of Legislative Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 10, § 26, sub-§ VII, amended. The last sentence of sub-section VII of section 26 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

'He (Director of Legislative Research) shall receive a salary of \$10,000 \$14,000 per year and any necessary traveling expenses;'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$4,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to the Office of Legislative Research to carry out the purposes of this act.
