STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Household Furniture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ V, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection V of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended by chapter 237 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'A. The household furniture, excluding including radios and television sets, of each person not exceeding \$500 to in any one household; and his wearing apparel, farming utensils and mechanics' tools necessary for his business.'
