**AN ACT Relating to Number of Signatures on Nomination Papers for
Town Officers.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 37, sub-§ III, amended. The first sentence of subsection III of section 37 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'The nomination for any office shall be made by nomination papers signed by ~~at least~~ the following number of voters based on the population of the town according to the last decennial census of the United States: **not less than 25 nor more than 50** in towns of 1,000 or less population; **not less than 50 nor more than 75** in towns of 1,001 to 4,000; **not less than 75 nor more than 100** in towns of 4,001 to 10,000; and **not less than 100 nor more than 125** in towns of more than 10,000.'
