IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of County Attorney of York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to the salary of the county attorney of York County, is amended to read as follows:

‘county attorney, ~~\$3,700~~ \$4,500;’

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1963.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$400 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963, the sum of \$800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to provide an increase in salary of the county attorney of York County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
