HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 857, L. D. 1244, Bill, "An
Act Relating to Permit to Operate Certain Farm Trucks."

Amend said Bill in the 4th and 6th lines by striking
out the underlined word and punctuation "unladen,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
2 underlined sentences and inserting in place thereof the
following underlined sentences:

"Each farm truck so operated shall have adequate brakes and
lights. The permit shall specify the route or routes of travel
and time of day during which such permit shall be valid. It
shall be unlawful to operate such a vehicle on the highway
at a distance of more than 10 miles from the place where the
vehicle is customarily kept.' "
