SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.862, L.D. 1249,
Bill, "An Act Relating to the Educational Foundation Program
Allowances."

Amend said Amendment in that part designated "Table I" by inserting at the end of the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th lines from the end of said table, after the stricken out " $\{2\}$ " the underlined figure 1 in parenthesis '(1)'

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end, before the single quotation mark, the following underlined paragraph:

'(1) Secondary school footnotes shall apply to all units,

except school administrative districts. If within 15 miles of a

school operated in a neighboring administrative unit by the nearest

suitable highway, compute all administrative units as follows:

At \$300 per pupil if 100 or fewer average daily membership.

At \$300 per pupil if 101 to 200 average daily membership.

At \$320 per pupil if 201 to 300 average daily membership.'
