IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Rules and Regulations by Public Utilities Commission Concerning Safety and Shelter for Railroad Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 46, § 76-B, additional. Chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 76-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 76-B. Additional powers and duties of Public Utilities Commission. The Public Utilities Commission is authorized to promulgate and enforce reasonable rules and regulations relating to safety, sanitation and adequate shelter as affecting the welfare and health of railroad trainmen, enginemen, yardmen, maintenance of way employees, highway crossing watchmen, clerical, platform, freight house employees, express employees, station agents and signal station operators.'
