STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing a Full-Time Economist for the Department of Economic Development.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38-A, § 2, amended. The first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 38-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 471 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'The commissioner may employ such division chiefs, deputies, assistants and employees as may be necessary, subject to the provisions of the Personnel Law; employ or engage with the approval of the Governor and Council **a specialist in economics and** such outside technical or professional consultants as may be necessary or appropriate to assist the department in carrying out its functions; and may enter into contracts with other boards, commissions, departments and divisions of the State or with the University of Maine to assist him or any division of the department in carrying out the provisions of this chapter.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Economic Development the sum of \$12,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$14,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
