STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Raccoons and Bobcats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'III. Bear, hedgehogs or bobcats. It shall be lawful to trap bear, hedgehogs or bobcats at any time anywhere in the State, and it shall be lawful to hunt bear **or** hedgehogs or bobcats at any time anywhere in the State except during Sundays and in the nighttime.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ III-A, additional. Section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection III-A, to read as follows:

'III-A. Raccoons and bobcats. It shall be lawful to hunt raccoons and bobcats at any time anywhere in the State from January 1st to September 30th of each year.'
