HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 974, L.D. 1302, Bill, "An Act Requiring Persons Seventy-five Years of Age to take Biennial Examination for Motor Vehicle Driver's License."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the word "Seventy-five" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Eighty'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 22, §60, amended. The 7th sentence of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 348 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'Any person upon reaching his 75th birthday shall be required to take an examination to qualify him to operate a motor vehicle and shall be required to take such examination upon reaching his 80th birthday and annually every 2 years thereafter.' "
