IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Requiring Persons Seventy-five Years of Age to take Biennial Examination for Motor Vehicle Driver's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 7th sentence of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 348 of the public laws of 1961, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Any person who has reached his 75th birthday and who has not taken an examination to qualify him to operate a motor vehicle within the past year shall be required to pass a driver's examination before a license may be issued to him. He shall pass such examination before renewal of the license in the future.'
