## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Teaching Benefits for Military Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 41, § 238-A, additional.** Chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 238-A, to read as follows:

#### 'Teaching Benefits for Military Service.

Sec. 238-A. Teaching benefits for military service. Any person employed as a teacher in the public schools of this State, following the honorable completion of military service in the forces of the United States, or of this State, for the purpose of eligibility for retirement and longevity benefits under the laws of this State, shall be entitled to one year of creditable service toward such benefits for each 2 years of military service and shall receive, upon employment, a credit of one year's teaching experience for each 2 years of military service in the assignment of his salary for such employment.'
