#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Qualifications for Voting at Local District Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 3-A, § 25, sub-§ V, additional. Section 25 of chapter 3-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1961, is amended by adding a new subsection V, to read as follows:
  - 'V. Voting at certain local district elections. Any person who is 21 years of age or more and who is jointly or severally liable to a town district or subdivision for taxes assessed against him on an assessment of not less than \$1,000 may vote at any special or regular election or referendum or at any meeting of any fire, sewer, water, school district or any other municipal subdivision of the town in which he has property assessed in a value of not less than \$1,000.'
