SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 909, L. D. 1316, Bill, "An Act Relating to Civil Liability of Legal Entities and Certain State Agencies."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting before the word "Legal" the word 'Non-Governmental'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 179-A." and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'Civil Liability of Non-governmental Legal Entities.

Sec. 179-A. Civil liability of non-governmental legal entities.

Any legal entity shall be civilly liable for the negligent or wrongful act or omission of its employees, performed within the scope of their employment, under circumstances where the legal entity, if a private person, would be liable for such act or omission.

I. Exceptions. The provisions relating to civil liability for tort claims shall not apply to the State of Maine, any state agency, any municipal corporation or any quasi-municipal corporation acting in their governmental capacities.' "
