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**AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Registration of Motor Vehicles Driven by  
Certain Persons When Arrested.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 22, § 162, amended.** The last sentence of section 162 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

'If ~~such~~ a person fails to appear in court on the day specified, either in person or by counsel, the court shall notify the Secretary of State, who shall immediately suspend or revoke his license, if licensed in this State, or suspend or revoke his right to operate motor vehicles in this State, if a nonresident and not licensed in this State, and also suspend ~~or annul~~ the registration of the motor vehicle driven by such person when arrested, if said motor vehicle is registered in this State by such person. The Secretary of State, in his discretion, may also suspend the registration of the motor vehicle driven by such person when arrested, if said motor vehicle is registered in this State by other than the operator of said motor vehicle.'
