STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Reapportionment of Party State Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 3-A, § 35, sub-§ II, ¶¶ D and E, amended. Paragraphs D and E of subsection II of section 35 of chapter 3-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1961, are amended to read as follows:

'D. Size of committees and method of election. The convention shall determine the size of the state district and county committees and the method of their election.

E. State committee. Elect a state committee to be composed of members from each county on the basis of 2 for each State Senator that that county is entitled to elect and at least one member from each county to be a woman."
